

Checklist for national visa application: Working Holiday Visa

Please prepare **one application set** with all the following documents in the given order.

Please DO NOT staple any documents.

Please note: Applicants must file their application before their 31st birthday, Canadian citizens before their 35th birthday. The following nationalities can apply for a Working Holiday in Dublin:

- Citizens of Chile, Argentina, Uruguay
- Citizens from Canada, Japan, Australia, New Zealand can apply in Dublin but also directly with the Immigration Office in Germany.
- Citizens from Israel, Hong Kong, Taiwan, Brazil must apply at the Embassy/Consulates in their country.

<input type="checkbox"/>	2 Passport size picture , not older than six months with a bright background and frontal view of the face. Digitally altered passport pictures will not be accepted.

<input type="checkbox"/>	Flight reservation
<input type="checkbox"/>	Proof of financial means
<input type="checkbox"/>	Argentinian citizens: Argentinian police record
<input type="checkbox"/>	Proof of housing in Germany for the first week (e.g., rental contract, hotel reservation) OR invitation letter in case of private accommodation with name, full address and their passport copy
<input type="checkbox"/>	Health insurance valid for whole duration of working holiday stay
<input type="checkbox"/>	Valid passport (issued within the last 10 years and valid for at least 6 months after arriving in Germany with at least two empty pages)

Please note that the German Embassy Dublin reserves the right to ask for additional documents at any time during processing. Submission of the above-mentioned documents does not guarantee that a visa is granted.
